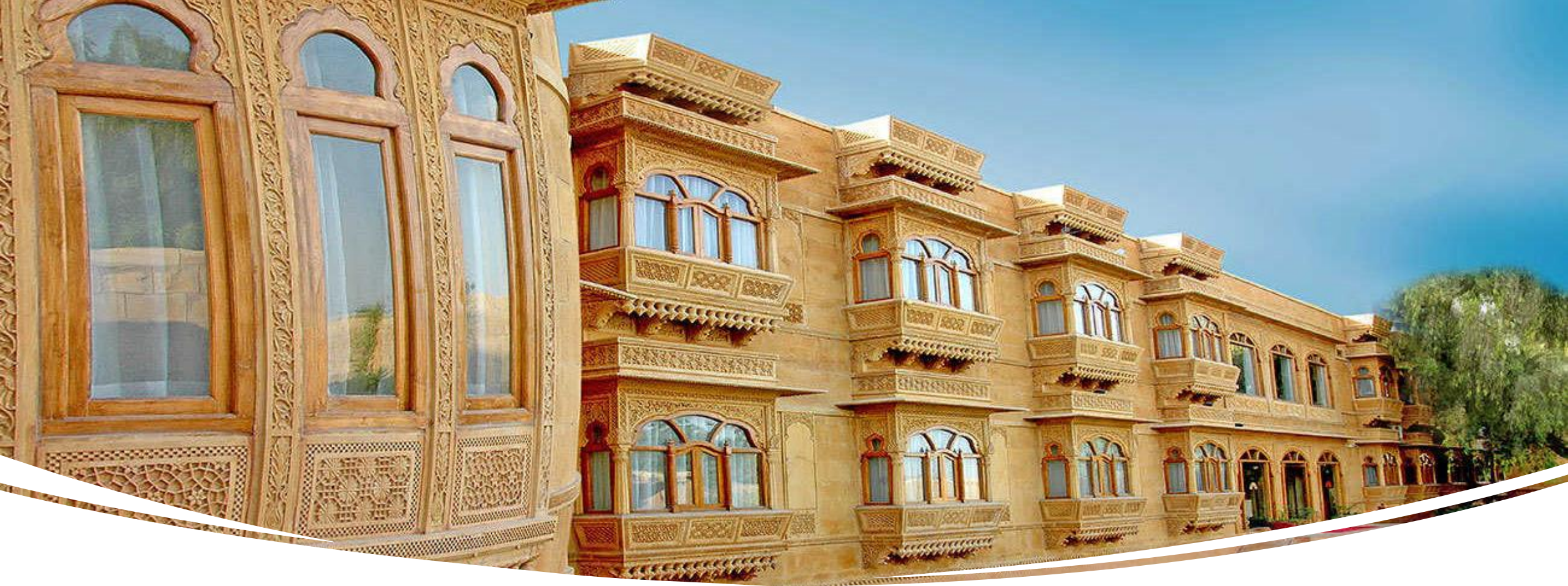

# JAISALMER

JAISALMER means the Hill Fort of Jaisal and is sometimes called the Golden City of India because the yellow sandstone used in every architecture of the city gives a yellowish-golden tinge to the city and its surrounding area. Situated in the middle of the vast Thar Desert, it is crowned by a commanding fort etched in yellow sandstone, with all its awesome splendour, dominating the amber-hued city. The fort actually functions as intended and is still the site of an entire living area, home to a quarter of the population.





## ITINERARY

- Day : 1 – Pick up from Jodhpur airport and head to Jaisalmer. Today visit Gadisar lake. This evening desert camel ride and jeep ride can be done optional.
- Day : 2 – After breakfast visit Jaisalmer fort, Patwon Ki Haveli and Abandoned Village post that Rajasthani folk dance and desert camp stay.
- Day : 3 – Head out to Jodhpur and visit Mandore garden and phool mahal.



# JODHPUR



- **CULTURE** - Jodhpur has culturally been known by the name of Jodhana by the locals.<sup>[28]</sup> The city is famous for its food and its popularity can be judged by the fact that one can find sweet shops named "Jodhpur Sweets" in many cities throughout India. Being at the onshore of Thar Desert, life has been influenced by ways of select nomadic tribes (so-called "gypsy" groups – Banjare in Hindi – have settled in some parts of the city).<sup>[29]</sup> Jodhpur has distinct cultural identity through its food and is famous for its Mirchi Bada and Mawa Kachori.
- **TOURISM** - Jodhpur's most notable attractions are Mehrangarh Fort which overlooks upon the city, the blue bylanes of the old city are also an attraction, Umaid Bhawan Palace, Jaswant Thada, and the Ghanta Ghar, or Clock Tower. Tourists are also within proximity to Mandore Garden, Kaylana Lake and Garden, Balsamand Lake, Machia Biological Park, Rao Jodha Desert Rock Park, Ratanada Ganesh Temple, Toorji Ka Jhalra, Sardar Samand Lake and Palace, Masooria Hills, Veer Durgadas Smarak (monument, park, and museum), Surpura Dam and Bhim Bhadak Cave. Other attractions of people are at markets of food, antique items, traditional clothes and traditional shoes (also called Jodhpuri Mojari) held in Jodhpur.<sup>[31]</sup> Mahamandira, a temple consecrated to Sri Jalandharnath, is known for its murals showing ascetics in yoga poses and murals bearing inscriptional records of the dignitaries visiting the shrine which includes Charanas, nobles, and the Rajas.



- Day : 4 – Today its time to explore sun city to places like Ghanta Ghar, Umaid Bhawan, Balsamand Lake, Mehrangarh fort, Toorjis step well.
- Day : 5 – After breakfast head to Jaipur and visit **Only Brahma temple in the world** at Pushkar and reach Jaipur. Have relaxing dinner at resort.
- Day : 6 – Welcome to royal heritage capital of Rajasthan. After breakfast visit Amer fort, Nagargarh Fort, City Palace, Jantar Mantar, Jai Mahal, Hawa Mahal.

# JAIPUR



Jaipur is the capital of India's Rajasthan state. It evokes the royal family that once ruled the region and that, in 1727, founded what is now called the Old City, or "Pink City" for its trademark building color. At the center of its stately street grid (notable in India) stands the opulent, colonnaded City Palace complex. With gardens, courtyards and museums, part of it is still a royal residence.

Jaipur is a major tourist destination in India forming a part of the Golden Triangle.<sup>[60]</sup> In the 2008 Conde Nast Traveller Readers Choice Survey, Jaipur was ranked the 7th best place to visit in Asia.<sup>[61]</sup> According to TripAdvisor's 2015 Traveller's Choice Awards for Destination, Jaipur ranked 1st among the Indian destinations for the year.<sup>[62]</sup> The Presidential Suite at the Raj Palace Hotel, billed at US\$45,000 per night, was listed in second place on CNN's *World's 15 most expensive hotel suites* in 2012
