

 - Canal Walk caters to the Northern Suburbs with the Southern Suburbs well served by malls like Cavendish Square and Blue Route Mall.
 - Market shopping is also HUGE in Cape Town with indoor and outdoor markets waiting for you to take advantage of their massive assortment of wares.
 - The best part of market shopping is that many of them are proudly South African or African with Green Market Square arguably the most famous of the 'fixed' markets.
 - Transfer back to your hotel to freshen up.
 - You will be met in the hotel reception by your driver guide for your private dinner transfer.
 - Dinner will be served at a local Indian restaurant.

• DAY 3

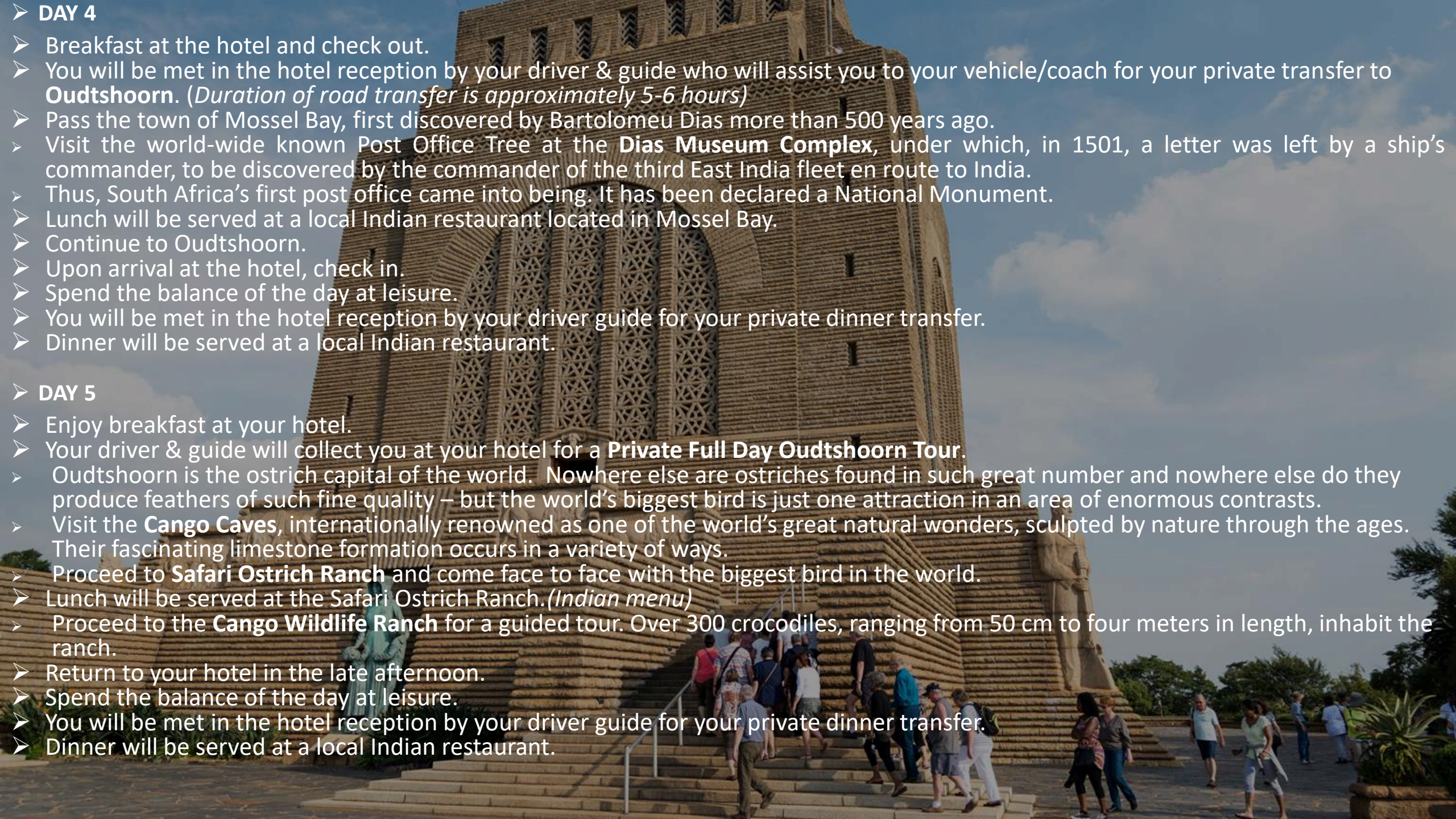
- Breakfast at the hotel.
- You will be collected at your hotel by your driver-guide for a **Private Full Day Cape Peninsula Tour**.
- Travel at a pace that allows you to explore the beauty of the Cape Peninsula.
- Depart for the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve along one of South Africa's most scenic routes, passing Hout Bay.
- Enjoy a cruise to Seal Island, to view seals and sea birds at Duiker Island (weather permitting). Tours depart at 08h45, 09h45, 11h00, 12h45, 14h45 or 15h45.
- During summer, several thousand Cape Fur Seals – along with the rare Black Cormorant – lollop leisurely among the kelp beds.
- Travel along Chapman's Peak Drive (conditions permitting).
- Lunch at a local seafood restaurant. (*Indian menu*)
- Visit the penguin colony at Boulders Beach.
- Continue to the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve.
- The scenery en route to Cape Point, at the South Western tip of the reserve, is particularly lovely in spring when wildflowers carpet the landscape.
- The new lighthouse – the most powerful in the world – beams an electric light of 19 million candle power across the ocean.
- Ascend to the top of by Funicular.
- Visit Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens (time permitting / optional cost). The Treetop Canopy Walkway gives visitors the opportunity to experience the forest from high above the ground. The galvanised steel structure meanders through trees and branches, with sections that crown above the forest.
- Return to your hotel.
- You will be met in the hotel reception by your driver guide for your private dinner transfer.
- Dinner will be served at a local Indian restaurant.

➤ DAY 4

- Breakfast at the hotel and check out.
- You will be met in the hotel reception by your driver & guide who will assist you to your vehicle/coach for your private transfer to **Oudtshoorn**. (*Duration of road transfer is approximately 5-6 hours*)
- Pass the town of Mossel Bay, first discovered by Bartolomeu Dias more than 500 years ago.
- Visit the world-wide known Post Office Tree at the **Dias Museum Complex**, under which, in 1501, a letter was left by a ship's commander, to be discovered by the commander of the third East India fleet en route to India.
- Thus, South Africa's first post office came into being. It has been declared a National Monument.
- Lunch will be served at a local Indian restaurant located in Mossel Bay.
- Continue to Oudtshoorn.
- Upon arrival at the hotel, check in.
- Spend the balance of the day at leisure.
- You will be met in the hotel reception by your driver guide for your private dinner transfer.
- Dinner will be served at a local Indian restaurant.

➤ DAY 5

- Enjoy breakfast at your hotel.
- Your driver & guide will collect you at your hotel for a **Private Full Day Oudtshoorn Tour**.
- Oudtshoorn is the ostrich capital of the world. Nowhere else are ostriches found in such great number and nowhere else do they produce feathers of such fine quality – but the world's biggest bird is just one attraction in an area of enormous contrasts.
- Visit the **Cango Caves**, internationally renowned as one of the world's great natural wonders, sculpted by nature through the ages. Their fascinating limestone formation occurs in a variety of ways.
- Proceed to **Safari Ostrich Ranch** and come face to face with the biggest bird in the world.
- Lunch will be served at the Safari Ostrich Ranch. (*Indian menu*)
- Proceed to the **Cango Wildlife Ranch** for a guided tour. Over 300 crocodiles, ranging from 50 cm to four meters in length, inhabit the ranch.
- Return to your hotel in the late afternoon.
- Spend the balance of the day at leisure.
- You will be met in the hotel reception by your driver guide for your private dinner transfer.
- Dinner will be served at a local Indian restaurant.

➤ You will be met in the hotel reception by your driver & guide who will assist you to your vehicle/coach for your private transfer to **Knysna**. (*Duration of road transfer is approximately 2 hours*).

➤ Explore the quaint town of Knysna known for its art & craft shops. “The place of the people, beauty and mystery.”

➤ This ever-popular charming town of legend, history, arts and crafts catering to visitor’s every need or fancy.

➤ The town is built on the banks of the Knysna Lagoon, a National Lake Area that falls under the protection of South African National Parks, is a home to more than 200 species of fish – including the rare Knysna seahorse – and is a popular destination for water sports enthusiasts and nature lovers alike.

➤ Lunch will be served at a local Indian restaurant.

➤ Upon arrival at the hotel, check in.

➤ Late afternoon, embark on a ferry trip aboard the pleasure boat, the **John Benn** (weather permitting).

➤ The John Benn is a double-decker floating restaurant offering daily Lagoon cruises to the Knysna Heads.

➤ A memorable family activity on Knysna Lagoon.

➤ Cruise to the Knysna Heads, on a boat steeped in history, named after a legendary pilot of a bygone era.

➤ Dinner will be served at a local Indian restaurant.

➤ The Tsitsikamma’s spectacular scenery includes the Indian Ocean breakers, pounding rocky shores beneath 180 m high cliffs, ever-green forests and fynbos rolling down to the sea.

➤ Lunch will be served at a local restaurant. (*Indian menu*)

➤ Return to the hotel and spend the balance of the day at leisure.

➤ You will be met in the hotel reception by your driver guide for your private dinner transfer.

➤ Dinner will be served at a local Indian restaurant.

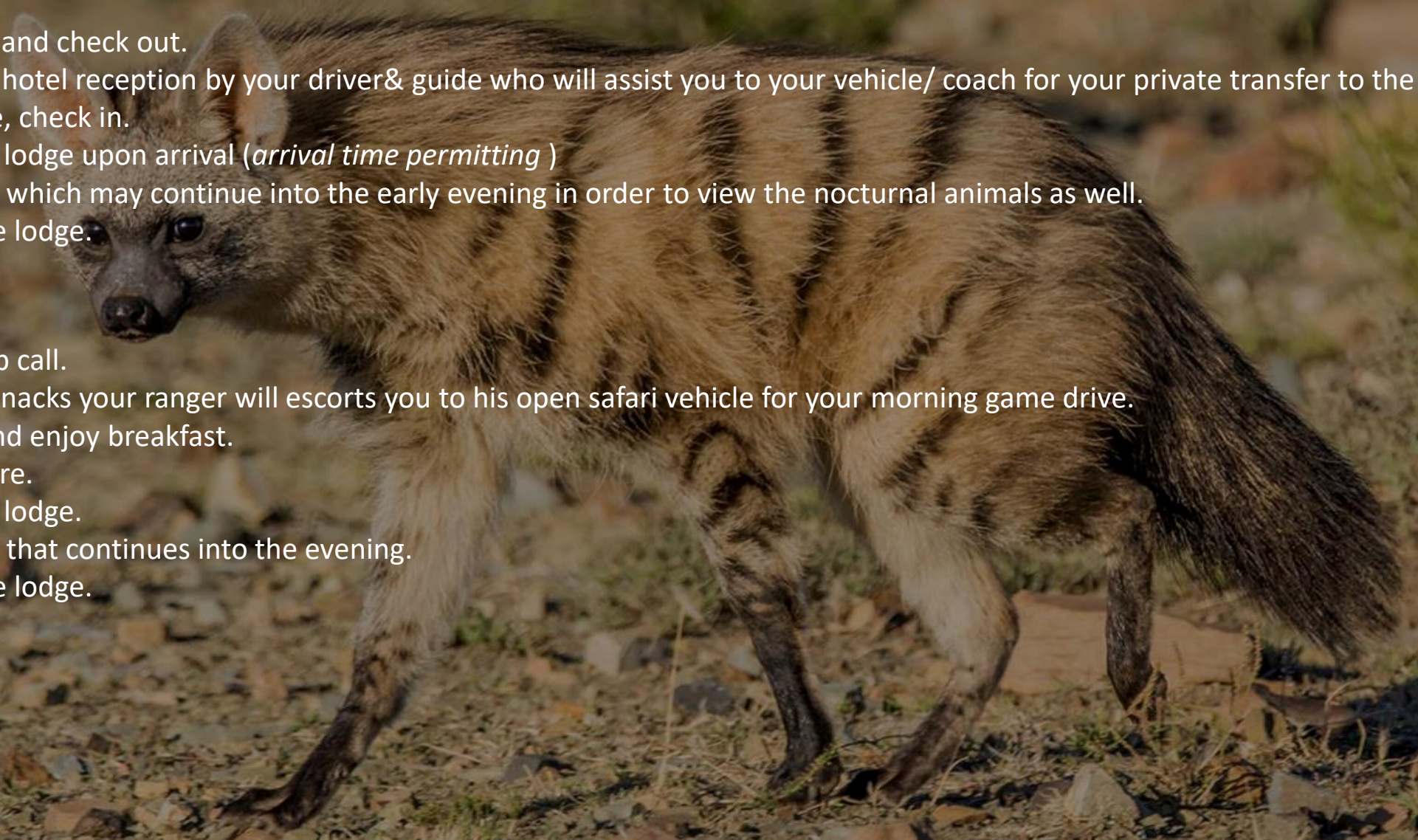
